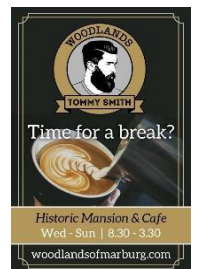
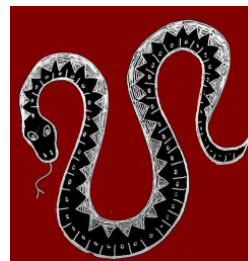

Category Information and How to Enter form part of the Terms and Conditions

- All work to be received at The Community Centre, 112 Queen St Marburg. Saturday 16 September 10am—2pm or Sunday 17 September 9am—11am.
- All work to be collected Saturday 23rd Sept 3pm to 5pm or Sunday 24th Sept 10am—2pm.
- Other times for receiving or collecting work may be arranged prior to the day.
- Entries may be received up to the drop off date but prior submissions preferred and appreciated.
- Limit of 3 pieces per artist.
- All works must be clearly labelled with Artist Name, Title and Sale Price (or NFS).
- All works (including photography) to be suitably presented ready to hang - framed or string /hooks.
- Works to be no larger than 1m x 1m.
- Photography/Digital Art minimum size 20cm x 25cm.
- Work must not have been previously exhibited at the Black Snake Creek Festival.
- One Novice prize is available to artists who have not previously entered the BSCF or won awards at other regional shows - excludes the photography/ digital art category.
- Prizes are issued at the discretion of the organisers and judges, and no debate will be entered into.
- Organisers reserve the right not to award a prize where insufficient entries are received.
- 15% commission on sale price will apply.
- Organisers have the right NOT to accept certain works at their discretion or to move work into alternative categories.
- Permission is granted for images to be used for advertising and promotion in this and other events.
- All care will be taken but no liability will be accepted for any loss or damage.
